SCREENING | BRIEF INTERVENTION | REFERRAL TO TREATMENT

In Q3 2025, we expanded Student Health Hub to all 26 schools in the district and 14 youth behavioral health providers. Since program launch in January 2024, hundreds of students have been screened, approximately 47% required follow-up, and 97% of those who requested additional care through the Hub were matched with a provider.

HERE'S A QUICK RECAP OF 2025 Q3



**"Student Health Hub"

763 students screened

for social emotional needs and substance abuse issues using the "Check Yourself" online tool developed by Seattle Children's Hospital.

47% of students screened required brief intervention

28% yellow flags (brief intervention),
20% red flags (immediate brief intervention)

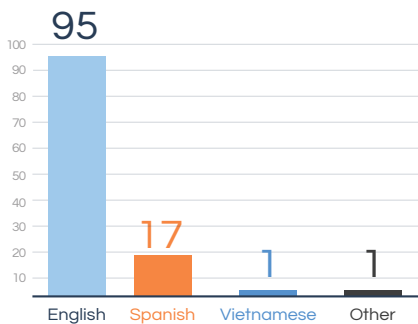

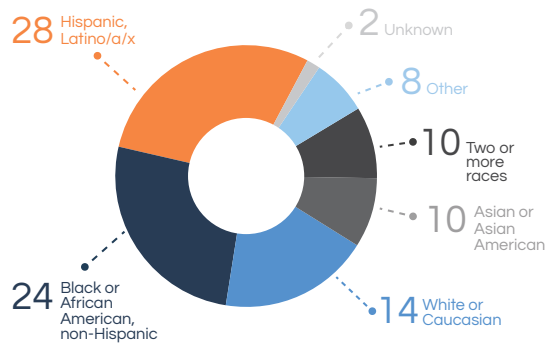

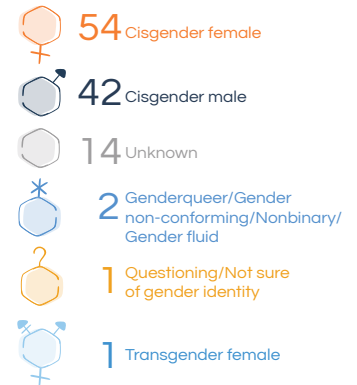
Student Preferred Language
