Supporting student well-being in Renton, Washington

SCREENING | BRIEF INTERVENTION | REFERRAL TO TREATMENT

In Q3 2024, we launched new Student Health Hub Software to support the 'Referral to Treatment' process at Dimmitt and Nelsen Middle Schools. We onboarded Asian Counseling and Referral Services (ACRS) and Project Be Free as two new hub providers, and formed a workgroup to co-design a new process that supports student referrals to housing assistance.

Since program launch in January 2024, hundreds of students have been screened, 50% required follow-up, and 100% of those who requested additional care through the Hub were matched with a provider.

HERE'S A QUICK RECAP OF 2024:



"Student Health Hub" launched in two middle schools: Dimmitt, and Nelson.



225 students screened for social emotional needs and substance abuse issues using the "Check Yourself" online tool developed by Seattle Children's Hospital.



50% of students screened required brief intervention
29% yellow flags (brief intervention),
21% red flags (immediate brief intervention)

Every student had a follow-up assessment with the school counselor if they had a screen with a red or yellow flag.

22 students referred to care after meeting with the school counselor.

22 students matched with a behavioral health service provider if referred to care.

8.14 days avg turnaround time from screening to referral match.

100% Closed Loop rate
Students needing a referral matched with a hub provider.

Every student needing a referral was matched with a hub provider.

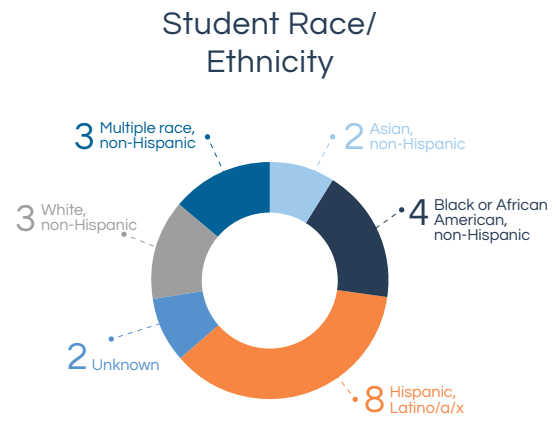
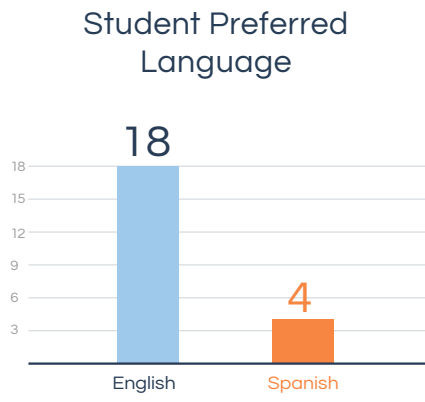
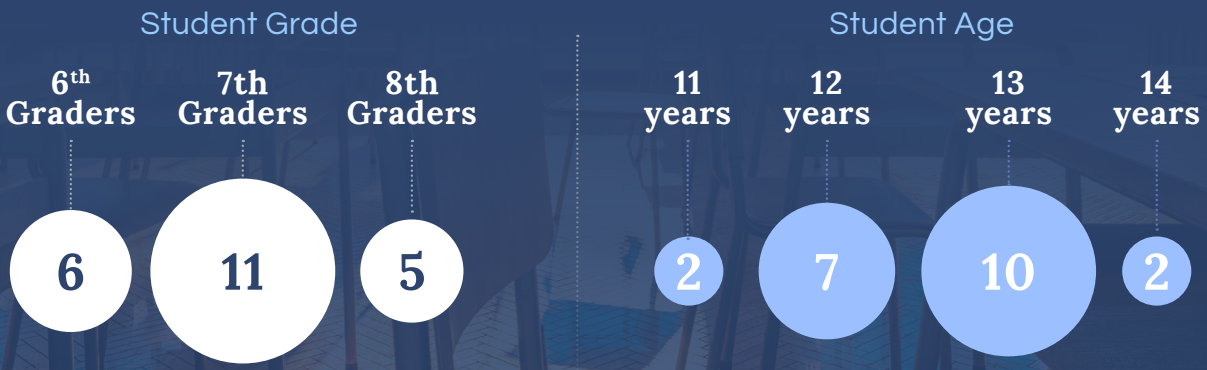
